BLESSED CARLOS ACUTIS WILL BE CANONIZED



on April 27, 2025, in Rome. Blessed Pier Giorgio Michelangelo Frassati will be canonized on August 3, 2025, in Rome. Both events will be part of the Jubilee Year of Hope celebrations. The Jubilee for Teenagers in Rome

takes place April 25-27 and the Jubilee for Youth (young adults aged 18-35) takes place July 28-August 3. The Diocese of Hamilton is not

sponsoring pilgrimages to Rome for these events; however, parishes may wish to mark the canonization of these two remarkable young men in their parishes. Blessed Carlos will be the first "millennial saint"!

WORLD DAY OF THE SICK 2025



The World Day of the Sick is observed each year on February 11, the liturgical commemoration of the Blessed Virgin Mary of Lourdes, with an especially solemn celebration taking place every three years at a Marian shrine.

However, in view of the Jubilee Year, Pope Francis has chosen to delay for one year the solemn celebration that would normally occur in 2025. The solemn commemoration of the World Day of the Sick will now take place in 2026, at the Marian Sanctuary of the Virgin of Chapi of Arequipa in Peru.

The Pope's decision was announced in a press release published on Monday morning by the Dicasteries for the Promotion of Integral Human Development and of Evangelization. The statement noted that for the Jubilee Year, the World Day of the Sick will be celebrated in the ordinary manner at the diocesan level, as usual on February 11; while at the same time noting the upcoming Jubilee of the Sick and Health Care Workers, set for April 5-6; and the Jubilee of People with Disabilities on April 28-29.

Pope John Paul II initiated the day in 1992 to encourage people to pray for those who suffer from illness and for their caregivers. The Pope himself had been diagnosed with Parkinson's a year before, in 1991, and it is considered that his own illness was impetus for his designation of the day.

World Day of the Sick was first observed on February 11, 1993. February 11 is also the Catholic Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes, which a name is given to the Virgin Mary in honor of the apparitions that were said to have been seen in and around Lourdes, France, by a young girl called Bernadette Soubirous. The Church canonized Bernadette as a saint several years later.
